



## **MABIS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022**

MABIS offers scholarships year-round, on a rolling admissions basis for students with exceptional academic performance and all-round abilities. Students will receive an annual reduction in tuition fees of: 50% and 100% for Grades 6-8.

Applications are accepted until May 30th, 2021. All forms, supporting information and letters of recommendation must be received by this date.

### **ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS**

- ❖ For students entering Grades 6-8 in August 2021
- ❖ Outstanding academic record as evidenced by class ranking, grade point average, external examination scores, etc.
- ❖ Strong English language proficiency
- ❖ Displays maturity, empathy, responsibility and other positive character traits which are supported by letters of recommendation
- ❖ Evidence of leadership roles and community service
- ❖ Active engagement in extracurricular activities (sports, music, technology, clubs, etc.)
- ❖ The scholarship offered will be based on the strength of the student's profile

### **ALL-ROUND ABILITIES SCHOLARSHIPS**

- ❖ All of the above qualifications apply
- ❖ Demonstrates talent or excellence in a particular area as evidenced by portfolio, awards, video recording of performances, news releases, etc.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- ❖ Fill out the scholarship application form
- ❖ Fill out the school application form (only for students new to MABIS)
- ❖ Submit two confidential letters of recommendation (2 teachers)
- ❖ Submit an essay (200 words max. for Grade 6, 500 words max. for Grades 7-8, handwritten)
- ❖ Sit a written assessment
- ❖ Attend a selection interview

### **TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS**

- ❖ The scholarship covers only the Entrance Fee (for new students only) and Tuition Fee. All other fees are payable as per normal with other students.
- ❖ The scholarship value is calculated by applying the tuition discount to the prevailing tuition rate in the academic year enrolled.
- ❖ Scholarships will be reviewed on an annual basis by the Management Team. Scholarships are valid for the entire duration of the student's enrollment at MABIS provided that the student continues to maintain good academic standing / special talent or abilities.
- ❖ Students commit to at least three years of enrollment at MABIS.
- ❖ Serious breaches of discipline will result in the immediate termination of the tuition discount offered through the scholarship for the remainder of the academic year.
- ❖ The scholarship is not convertible to cash.
- ❖ The school shall have the final authority over the interpretation of the terms and conditions of the scholarship and will not entertain any queries pertaining to the approach used in awarding the scholarships.
- ❖ Scholarships are awarded on a rolling basis.

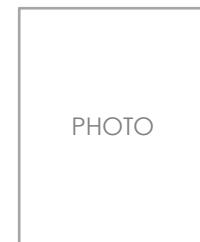
